As Mathematicians we will...

explore the terms 'multiplication' and its relationship with division. We will also learn about the distributive and commutative laws, and begin to multiply and divide numbers by 10 and 100.

Alongside this, we will continue to practise our times tables, focusing on our speed and accuracy.

As Scientists we will...

gain an understanding of scientific discoveries linked to electricity and how these have had implications on science and technology today. We will perform tests and make observations, whilst investigating electricity in everyday life, using our understanding to make predictions for the future.

In PF we will...

develop our agility, balance and coordination through a variety of performance challenges.

In Computing we will...

consider how and why data is collected over time. We will also collect and input data to review and draw conclusions from. We will examine what is meant by the term 'digital footprint' and analyse online profiles in our e-safety sessions.
