As Geographers we will...

identify and compare the physical and human features of Hull and Freetown. We will use maps to locate the two cities and know the countries in which they are located. We will make links with prior learning about human and physical features associated with our local area and farming topics explored earlier in the year and in year 1.

As Scientists we will...

ask questions, investigate and identify the basic needs of animals and notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. We will work scientifically, observing and measuring how different animals, including humans, grow. We will be able to describe the importance of a healthy lifestyle.

As Mathematicians we will...

explore commutativity, doubling and halving when using our two, five and ten times table to solve problems. We will develop our knowledge of measure through a range of practical tasks exploring capacity, volume and mass. We will continue to develop efficient methods for addition and subtraction of two, two digit numbers.
