Maths Challenge

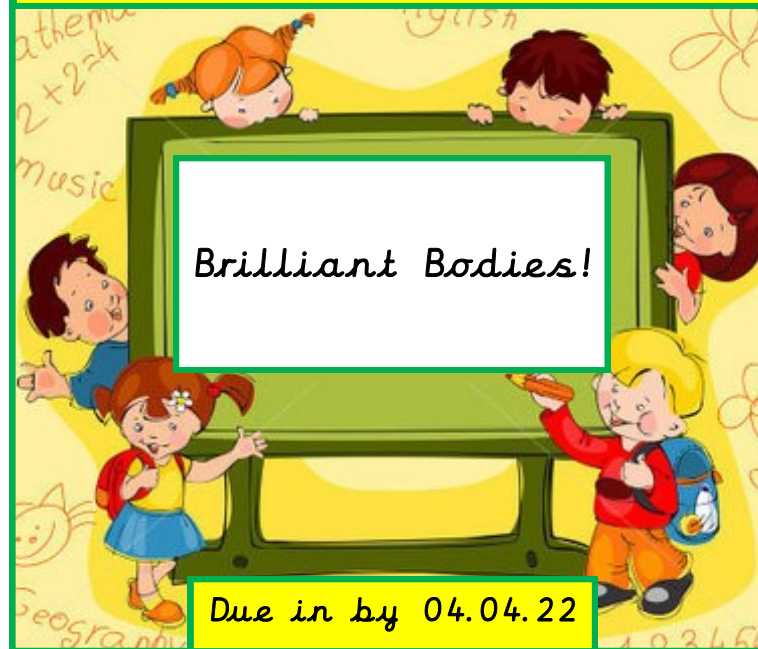
Can you share things between yourself and a parent and write the total, and how many each person gets? You could use lego, cheerios, maltesers ... anything!
